
Project Summary - Webinar on Zero Waste and Climate Change

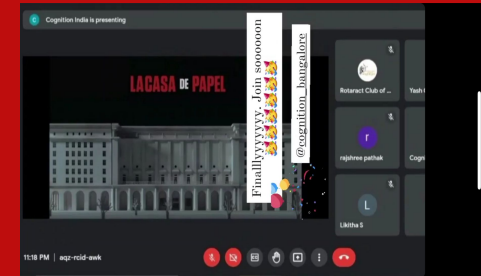
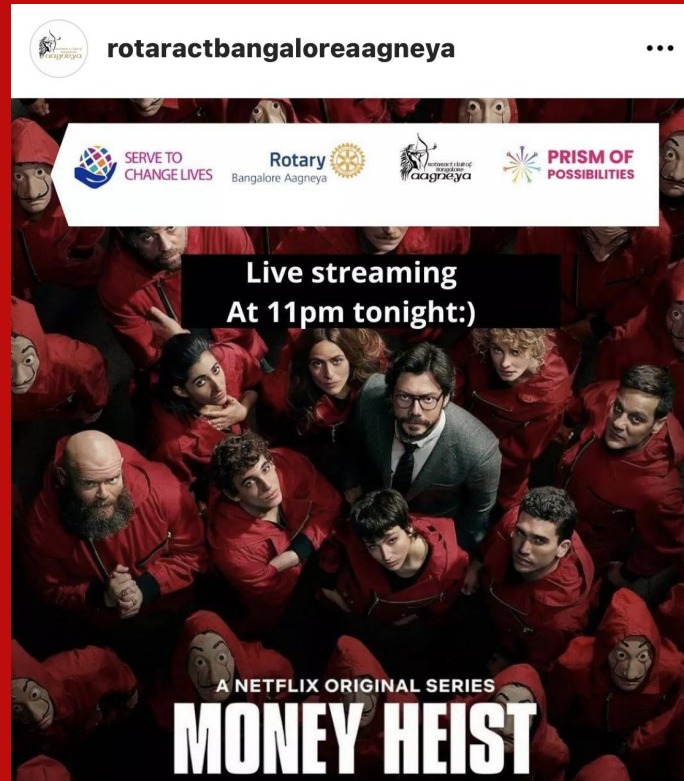

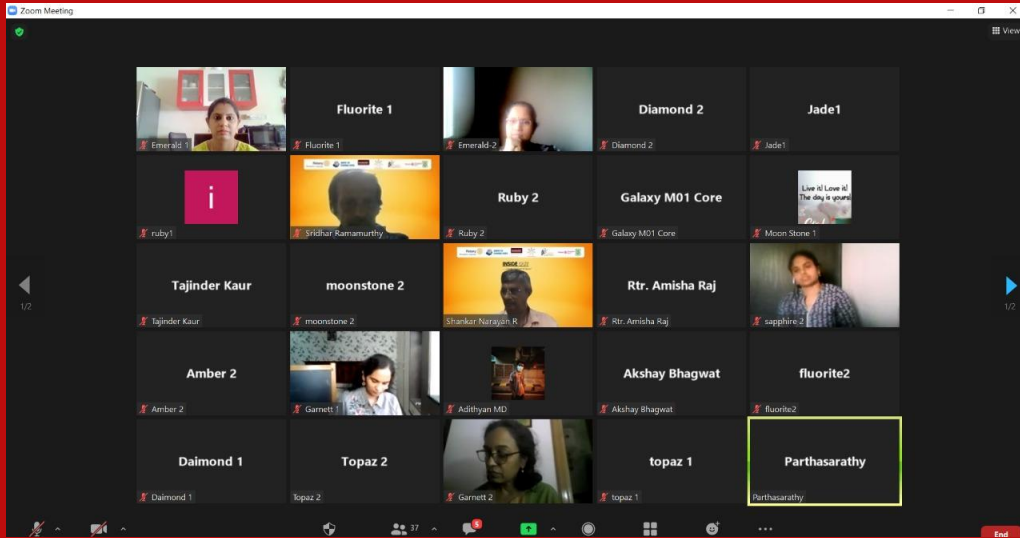
Many Rotaract members, teachers and students joined this event.
